Fees and Charges

It is strongly encouraged to obtain financial information prior to entering an aged care facility. It is important care recipients, or their representatives contact Centrelink to complete and lodge the **Residential Aged Care Calculation of your cost of care form (SA457)**.

It is also important to think about completing the **Authorising a person or organisation to enquire or act on your behalf form (SS313)**, obtained at the Centrelink office.

Basic Daily Care Fee (BDCF): An amount that everyone pays for the day-to-day services they will receive at the aged care home. This is set by the Department of Health and is equivalent of 85% of the single aged pension including supplementary rental assistance. This fee is indexed each year in March and September.

Means-tested Care Fee (MTCF): A contribution that some people pay toward the cost of their care, determined by a means assessment. Your means tested care fee will be between \$0 and \$400.08 per day. The maximum MTCF changes with indexation. There are annual and lifetime caps that apply to MTCF. Once you reach a cap, you cannot be asked to pay any more in MTCF.

Accommodation Costs: An amount that some people pay to contribute towards or cover the full costs of their room, depending on their means assessment. If you are required to pay an accommodation cost, there are three options to pay for your accommodation:

- A refundable lump sum amount (RAD)
- Rental-style daily payment (DAP/DAC), or
- A combination of both.

Until you decide how to pay for your accommodation, you will need to pay by rental-style daily payments.

Additional Services Fees: Fees for services that go beyond the minimum care and service requirements. This may include fees for hairdresser, nurse escort for appointments and outings, among others. Because additional services and corresponding fees are specific and set by the provider, these fees are not subsidised by the government.
