

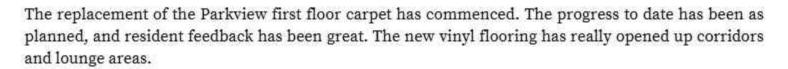

A Message from the CEO

Works in progress:



Whilst the project to install the vinyl floor is going to plan, there has been a level of disruption on residents, and I wish to thank all our residents and families for your support during this time.

The work to replace the lighting in Parkview's corridor and lounge areas and in the Gardens Dining room has commenced. The work to date has seen significant improvement in lighting and also the aesthetics of these areas. There has been a slight delay in progressing this project due to illness of one of the contractors employees.

3 reputable painting contractors have been invited to tender to paint all the internal common areas of the Parkview and Gardens buildings. Separate, on site meetings with each painting contractor will be undertaken, where the tender document outlining the scope of works and colour schedule will be released. Tenders will close, 27th June 2025, and we expect that painting works will commence in August 2025.

A Message from the Residential Services Manager

Dear Residents, Families, and Staff,

As we welcome the cooler winter months, I would like to take this opportunity to share some important updates and reminders to help us continue providing a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for everyone in our care.

Flu Season - Vaccination Program

As we enter the winter season, it is important to stay proactive in protecting our community from seasonal illnesses. We are currently in the process of rolling out our annual Flu Vaccination Program, and we are pleased to share that most of our residents have already received their flu vaccine. Vaccination is one of the most effective ways to reduce the risk of serious illness—especially for older adults—and plays a vital role in keeping everyone in our home healthy and safe.

In addition to the flu vaccine, we are also supporting access to the Shingles Vaccine, which provides important protection against a painful and preventable condition that can affect older adults. If your loved one would like to receive either the Flu or Shingles Vaccine, or if you're unsure about their current vaccination status, we encourage you to speak directly with one of our RNs or our CCCs. They will be more than happy to assist you with any questions and help complete the necessary steps. Copies of the vaccination assessment and consent forms are available for your convenience at Reception in Parkview. Please do not hesitate to pick up a copy and return it at your earliest convenience if your loved one has not yet participated. Together, we can help protect our residents and create a healthier environment for all.

Mindful Mealtime Visits

We love seeing families spending time with their loved ones, especially during mealtimes, which are an important part of our residents' daily routine. However, to ensure a calm and enjoyable dining experience for all, we kindly ask families to limit the number of visitors during mealtimes. If more than one visitor is expected, please speak with our Lifestyle Coordinator in advance so we can book a private space near the Lifestyle Office. This helps reduce noise and ensures a peaceful dining environment for all residents.

Visitor Sign-In: A Safety Priority

We have observed that some visitors are not signing in or out—particularly on weekends. We want to remind everyone that signing in and out at the reception is essential for safety reasons, especially in case of an emergency such as a fire. This simple step ensures we are aware of who is on-site at all times and can keep everyone safe.

Advance Care Planning - A Vital Discussion

I want to highlight the importance of Advance Care Directive and Advance Care Plan. Advance Care Directive/Planning is an important part of ensuring each resident's values and healthcare preferences are respected, especially as health needs change. These documents help us understand your loved one's wishes should their health deteriorate. If an Advance Care Plan/ Directive has not been completed yet, one of our Registered Nurses or Clinical Care Coordinator will be in contact to assist you. These plans ensure that your loved one's care aligns with their values and preferences.

Food Register - Keeping Our Community Safe

As part of our commitment to food safety, we remind all visitors to log any food brought in from outside in the Food Register, located at Reception. This helps us monitor potential allergens and maintain our residents' health and safety. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Important Reminder: Restrictive Practices Requirement

We would like to remind all families and representatives about the government's requirements concerning restrictive practices in aged care settings. Some of you may have already addressed this, and we thank you for your prompt action. However, there are still a number of outstanding cases that need to be completed.

This is a very important compliance requirement from the government. If your loved one is currently subject to any form of restrictive practice—such as chemical, physical, or environmental restraints—it is mandatory that they have a designated guardian or decision-maker associated with this specific function.

If you have received a letter from me regarding this matter, we kindly ask that you respond as soon as possible to ensure we meet regulatory obligations and continue to provide care that is both lawful and aligned with your loved one's best interests.

If you require any assistance completing the necessary forms or would like more information, please do not hesitate to speak with a member of our team. We are here to help guide you through the process. Your cooperation and understanding in this important matter are truly appreciated.

Thank you all for your continued support and cooperation. Your partnership helps us deliver the best possible care and environment for our residents. Let us continue to keep our community safe, respectful, and full of warmth this winter.

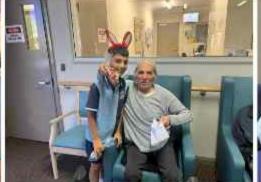
SCHOOL VISIT FOR EASTER

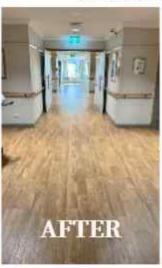




WHAT'S NEW AT SWIAA

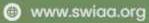
